### RIP RAP ~ 9:00

Included will be repair and maintenance of rip rap, when does your shoreline need repair and what work needs permitting. ### NATIVE PLANTINGS ~ 10:15

Patrick Goggin, UW-Extension with specialization in shoreline protection, will cover the basics of what plantings are best for shoreline protection that also add beautification as well as providing native habitat. He will review the Healthy Lakes Program which provides DNR grants up to \$1,000 to property owners to fund these projects. Pictures from some of the 11 Healthy Lakes projects on Beaver Dam Lake will be part of the program as well as information as to how you can participate in this successful program.
