<b>You can also adapt tools you may already have for a minimal cost:</b>	
Pipe insulation on tool handles - secured with tape or clamps.	\$ Supply Cost
Homemade seed tape - strips of newspaper or toilet paper, water soluble glue, small artist paint brush, and seeds.	\$ Supply Cost
Homemade standup seeder - piece of round dowel and PVC pipe clamped together with the dowel longer than the PVC; use the dowel to make the hole and drop the seed through the PVC pipe.	\$ Supply Cost
