REPORT

Map invasive species in Wisconsin* and upload your reports by the end of the month. WIFDN will review the reports for the month to determine who has successfully completed that month's challenge!

* In months where the challenge focuses on particular species, WIFDN still encourages ALL invasive species reports, even if they don't count toward the current month's challenge.
