January 30, 2008 (Wednesday), 10:30-11:50 a.m. **INITIATING COMMUNITY-BASED REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT IN YOUR DOWNTOWN (#1761-1)**. An increasing number of downtown groups are leading revitalization efforts through real estate development. This program provides an opportunity to hear about several case studies in two Wisconsin communities, Beloit and Ripon. Presenters from both communities will share their insights, experiences and lessons learned from their work. *Moderated by Chuck Law, Local Government Center; presented by Andrew Janke, Economic Development Director, City of Beloit; and Craig Tebon, Executive Director, Ripon Main Street, Inc.*



February 27, 2008 (Wednesday), 10:30-11:50 a.m. **LOCAL SUBDIVISION REGULATION AND THE USE OF IMPACT FEES (#1761-2)**. The regulation of subdivisions of land is an important, though often misunderstood, implementation tool. This session will provide an overview of the legal authority for local governments to regulate subdivisions and land divisions in Wisconsin. The session will review the basic components of a subdivision ordinance and highlight techniques for innovation such as conservation subdivisions. Finally, the session will cover recent changes to the impact fee statutes and related mechanisms for financing public improvements as part of the land division process. *Moderated by Jim Schneider, Local Government Center; presented by Brian Ohm, Department of Urban & Regional Planning, and Mike Slavney, Director of Planning Services, Vandewalle & Associates, Madison.*

March 26, 2008 (Wednesday), 10:30-11:50 a.m. **RECENT CASE LAW (#1761-3)**. This program will highlight recent Wisconsin cases and attorney general opinions, as well as important federal cases, relating to land use planning and implementation. *Moderated by Jim Schneider, Local Government Center; presented by Richard K. Nordeng and Christopher B. Hughes, attorneys at Stafford Rosenbaum, LLP, Madison.*

April 9, 2008 (Wednesday), 10:30-11:50 a.m. **GROWING COMMUNITIES - GREENING COMMUNITIES: MANAGING WISCONSIN'S SHORELANDS (#1761-4)**. Wisconsin is faced with the challenge of balancing development around Wisconsin's lakes and rivers in order to protect water quality, fish and wildlife habitat, and scenic beauty. For several years, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has been working with an advisory committee to update ch. NR115 - Wisconsin's Shoreland Management Program - that establishes minimum standards for county shoreland zoning ordinances. The revision effort focuses on protecting water quality and wildlife habitat as well as ensuring that property owners have reasonable use of their lands. This session will preview proposed changes to NR 115, responding to suggestions made during summer 2007 public hearings on the draft new rule. *Moderated by Elaine Andrews, UW-Extension Environmental Resources Center; presented by Greg Breese, Shorelands Team Leader, DNR Bureau of Watershed Management.*



WHAT IS A WISLINE?
