April 13, 2011 (Wednesday), 10:30-Noon. LEGISLATION AND CASE LAW UPDATE (#1779-6). Recent Wisconsin court decisions and legislation related to land use planning and implementation are highlighted and reviewed. *Moderated and Presented by Brian W. What is a WisLine?

A WisLine is a live teleconference offered by the University of Wisconsin-Extension. Register by mail, fax or phone to attend at a public WisLine site convenient to you. The day of the program, you will go to a room at the public site set up for two-way sound communication. Because there is no visual presentation in these teleconferences, you will receive a packet of printed materials that will be referred to throughout the program and that you can keep for future reference.

These will be shipped out after LGC receives the recording from the WisLine technical team. January 12, 2011 (Wednesday), 10:30-Noon. IMPLEMENTING THE NEW SHORELAND REGULATIONS (#1779-3). Updated shoreland regulations in NR 115 took effect February 2010, keeping some standards, revising others while introducing new ones. Counties must update their shoreland ordinances by February 2012 to comply with the new rules. Learn the essentials for updating your ordinances or just find out the current shoreland protection law in Wisconsin. *Moderated by Philip Freeburg, Local Government Center; presented by Department of Natural Resources Shoreland Coordinator and Mark Roffers, Vandewalle & Associates, Inc.*

February 9, 2011 (Wednesday), 10:30-Noon. ZONING AND ADULT ENTERTAINMENT BUSINESSES (#1779-4). Courts have protected adult bookstores and entertainment businesses as free speech under the First amendment, but they have also recognized that zoning laws may address the secondary effects of these businesses. The result is a challenging, sometimes risky and constantly evolving legal environment for local zoning ordinances affecting sexually oriented business. Find out the latest developments with the basics local governments need to know. *Moderated by Philip Freeburg, Local government Center; presented by Remzy D. Bitar, Crivello Carlson, SC and Dan Olson, League of Wisconsin Municipalities.*

March 2, 2011 (Wednesday), 10:30-Noon. WISCONSIN'S REVISED RUNOFF MANAGEMENT RULES: RATIONALE AND POTENTIAL IMPLICATIONS (#1779-5). Summer 2010, Wisconsin Natural Resources Board approved revisions to a suite of rules regarding polluted runoff and water quality, specifically addressing phosphorus. This program reviews the rationale for the changes and discusses potential implications for local governments. *Moderated by Brian W. November 10, 2010 (Wednesday), 10:30-Noon. WIND TURBINE SITING REGULATIONS (#1779-1). Fall 2009, Wisconsin adopted a new law setting restrictions on local regulation of wind turbines and directing the Public Service Commission to enact uniform standards for local wind turbine siting ordinances. These rules are expected to go into effect November 2010. Find out the wind turbine standards your local government can and cannot establish and enforce. *Moderated by Philip Freeburg, Local Government Center; presented by Deborah Erwin, Wisconsin Public Service Commission.*

December 15, 2010 (Wednesday), 10:30- Noon. WORKING LANDS MYTH BUSTERS (#1779-2). The new Working Lands Initiative for farmland preservation has generated lots of discussion since its inception. This WisLine session addresses frequently expressed concerns and misconceptions about Working Lands. Get acquainted with Working Lands through actual questions and comments heard during trainings, hearings, and speeches by DATCP personnel and planners.
